Step by Step

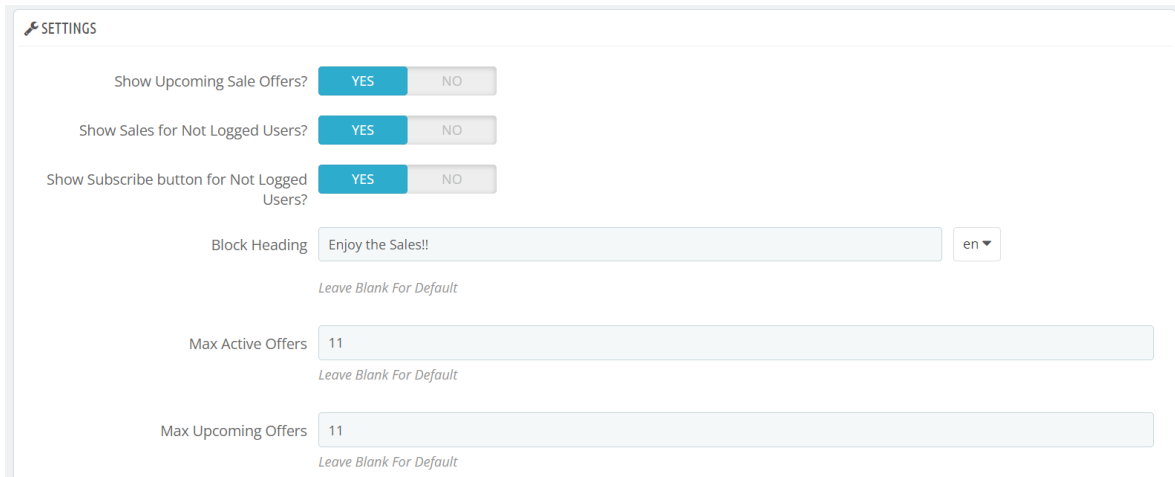
General Installation instructions

1. Log into PrestaShop administration panel, go to **Modules** → Click **Add new module**.
2. Select **privatesales.zip** which you downloaded and click **Upload this module**.
3. Scroll down and find **Private Sales** and click **Install**. You are done
4. **Clear Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**.
5. Make sure **Cache** is disabled in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**.
6. Module will add extra Tab in BO Menu Block.

Configuring Private Sales

To find configuration navigate yourself to **Modules** → **Find Private Sale Module** → **Click Configure**.

You can control your private sales blocks from this configuration page like writing a custom heading, hide/show upcoming offers, Show Sales for Non-Logged in users, Show subscribe button for not logged in users, number of offers to show.

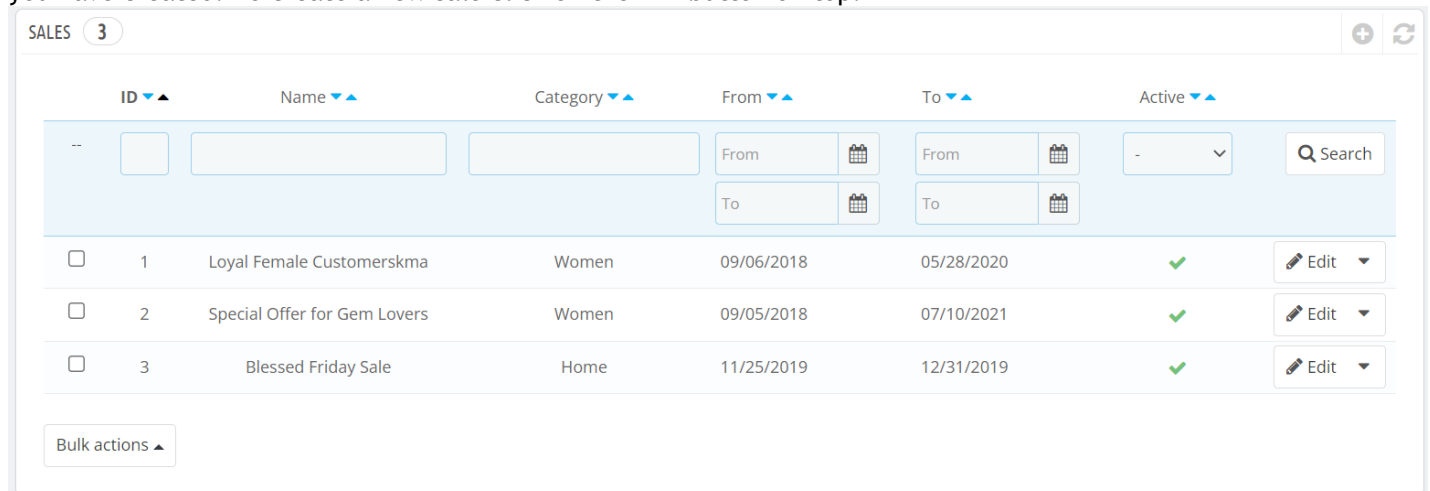

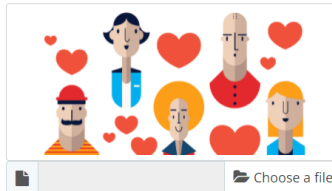
