## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

*Compatible - PrestaShop 1.6.x - 1.7.x*

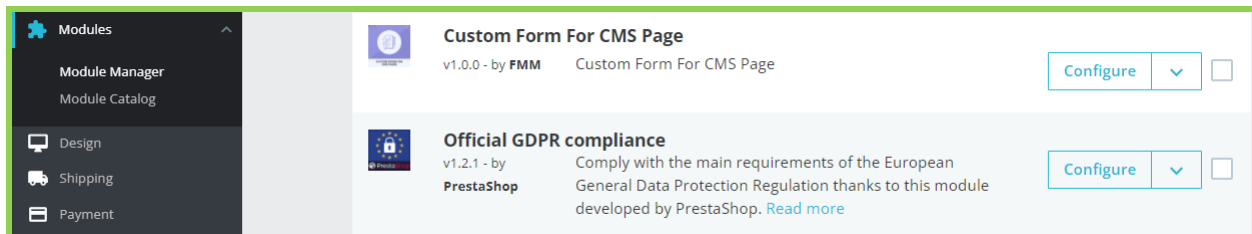
1. Log in to **PrestaShop** administration panel, go to **Modules** → Click **Add new module**
2. Select **v1.0.0cmscustomforms.zip** which you have downloaded and click **Upload this Module**
3. Scroll down and find "**Custom Form for CMS Page**" and click **Install**
4. **Clear Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**



## USER GUIDE

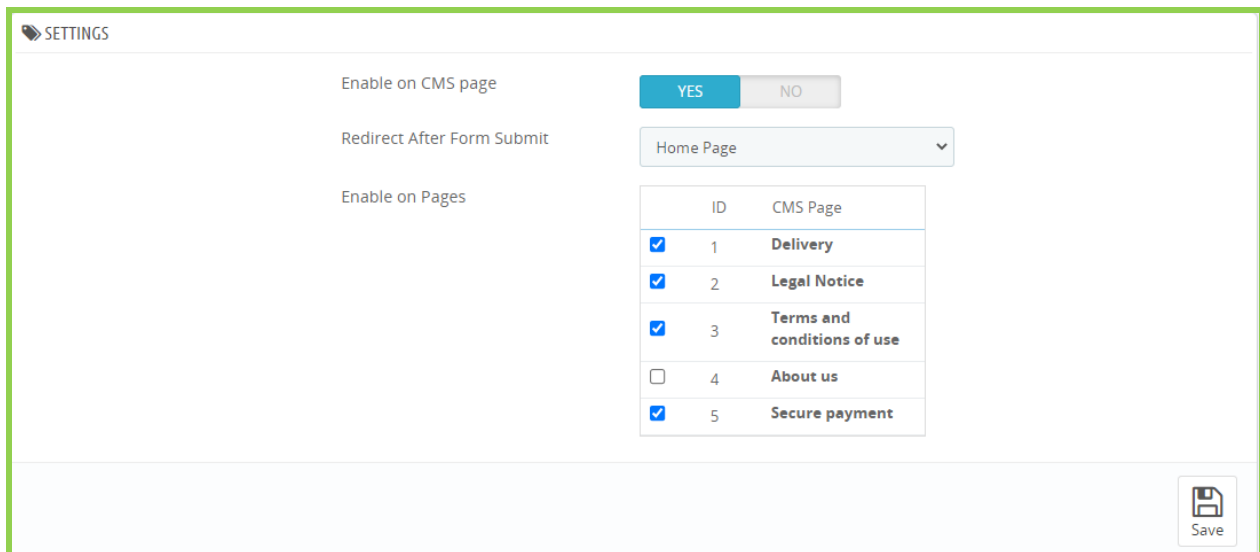
### HOW TO CONFIGURE MODULE

At the back office, go to **Modules > Module Manager > Custom Form for CMS Page**. From here admin can uninstall, disable or reset the module.



### GENERAL SETTINGS

Admin can configure module settings from here.



- **Enable on CMS Page:** Option to enable the form on CMS pages.
- **Redirect After Form Submit:** Option to choose the page where the user will be redirected after form submission.
- **Enable on Pages:** Option to select pages to display the form.

- **Field Status**

- **Values Required:** Option to make fields Required / Mandatory.
- **Field Status:** Option to enable/disable field on the form.

- **Field Name**

- **Field Name:** Option to name the field.
- **Field Size:** Option to set the size for the field. Use 0 if you do not want to add any limit for the field.

- **Fields Types and Validations**

- **Field Type:** Eleven field types to choose from, ie; text field, date, multiple select, etc.
- **Default Value:** Option to add default field value.
- **Field Validation:** Option to use the validations according to the requirements.

Admin can manage the form data received by users, ie; admin can View or Delete the data.
