INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Compatible - PrestaShop 1.6.x - 1.7.x

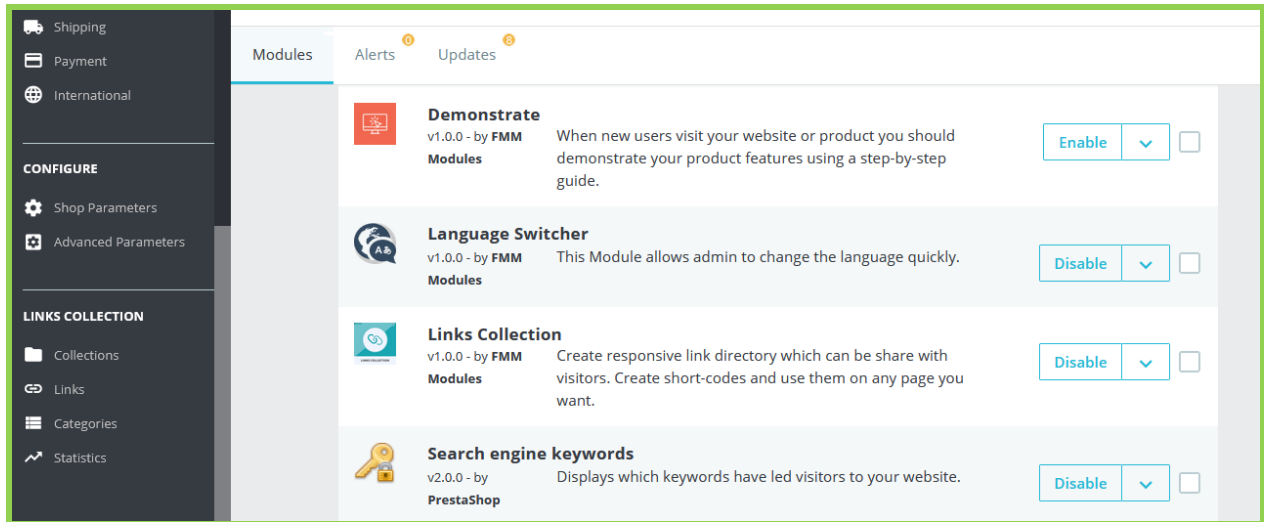
1. Log in to **PrestaShop** administration panel, go to **Modules** → Click **Add new module**
2. Select **v1.0.0LinksCollection.zip** which you have downloaded and click **Upload this Module**
3. Scroll down and find **Links Collection** and click **Install**. You are done
4. **Clear Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**



USER GUIDE

HOW TO CONFIGURE MODULE

At the back office, just after you Login to the admin panel you will find the features of Links Collection Module in the menu.



Under the Links Collection Heading, you will find its sub-menu:

- Collections
- Links
- Categories
- Statistics



1. COLLECTIONS:

Admin can create multiple Link Collections on different pages by setting the following configurations:

DISPLAY OPTIONS

Admin can use the display options in order to show the beautiful collection in the front office.

Admin can use the shortcode in order to display the link collection on anywhere in the front office.

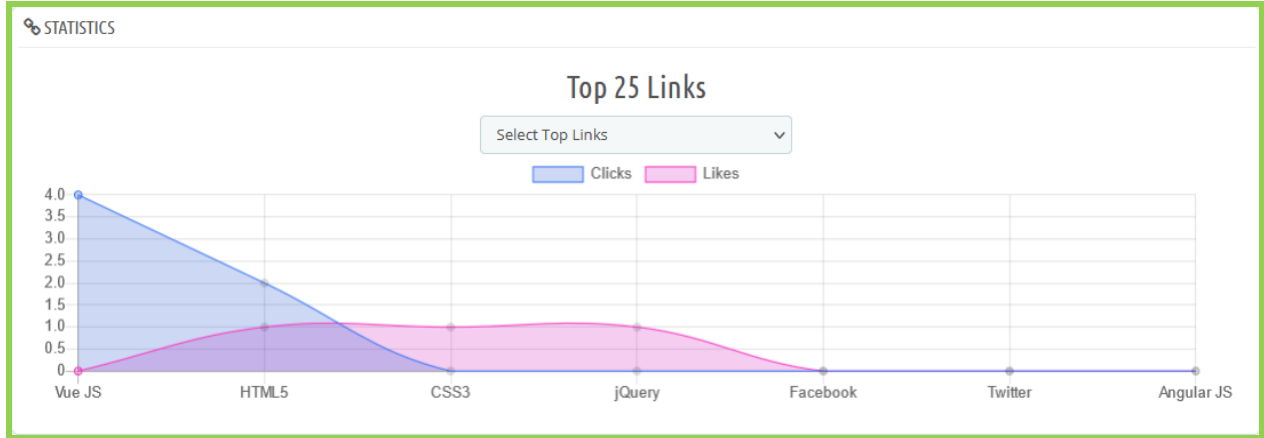
