INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Compatible - PrestaShop 1.6.x – 1.7.x

1. Log in to **PrestaShop** administration panel, go to **Modules** → Click **Add new module**
2. Select **v1.0.0WebpImages.zip** which you have downloaded and click **Upload this Module**
3. Scroll down and find **Webp Images** and click **Install**.
4. **Clear Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**



USER GUIDE

HOW TO CONFIGURE MODULE

At the back office, go to **Modules > Module Manager > Webp Images**. Here you will find all the module configurations.

- **Enable / Disable Module**
- **Image Type:** Option to choose Image type from the drop down list in order to convert into webp image.
- **Image Quality:** Option to set the Image quality of the webp image.
- **Product Images:** Enable this option in order to convert the Product images into webp images.
- **Category Image:** Enable this option in order to convert the Category images into webp images.
- **Supplier Images:** Enable this option in order to convert the Suppliers images into webp images.
- **Manufacturer Images:** Enable this option in order to convert the manufacturers images into webp images.
- **Store Images:** Enable this option in order to convert the Store image into webp images.
