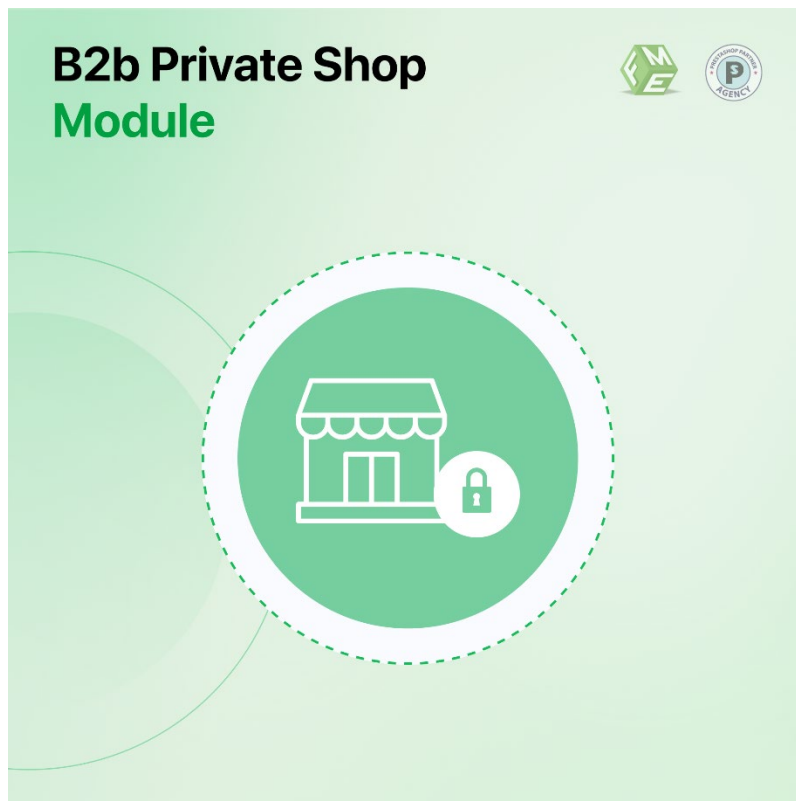

Installation Instructions

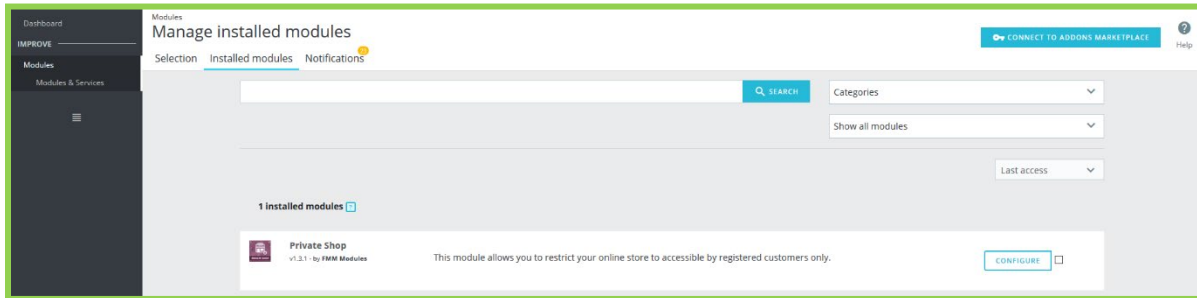
- Log into PrestaShop administration panel, go to Modules → Click Add new module.
- Select privateshop.zip which you downloaded and click Upload this module.
- Scroll down and find Private Shop and click Install. You are done
- Clear Cache in Advance Parameters → Performance.
- For Settings Go to Modules → Modules → find Private Shop and click Configure.



User Guide

How to Configure the Module:

At the back office, go to “Module & Services” and click on the “Installed Modules” tab. Here you will find your module. Click on “Configure” to continue.



General Settings

- **Login Title:** Title of Login dialog box
- **Signup Title:** Title of signup dialog box
- **Form Position:** Select where you want to show your form
- **Form Theme:** Default theme will use your store theme stylesheet.
- **Form Background Opacity:** Here you can select the opacity of form
- **Enable Signup:** Enable to enable signup option on frontend
- **Disable Birthday in Signup:** Option to disable birthday input field
- **Disable Gender in Signup:** Option to disable gender input field
- **Disable Newsletter in Signup:** Option to disable the newsletter signup option
- **Disable Offers Signup:** Option to disable offers signup on frontend
- **Restrict New Accounts?** Enabling this option will allow you to manually approve each new sign up request
- **Show store title?:** Do you want to show store title right after logo on form?
- **Enable Header and Footer:** Enable to show header and footer on private login page
- **Use Custom Logo:** Here you can upload custom logo
- **New Accounts Message:** This message will be displayed after registration of restricted customers.



- Background:** Background for the login page. Admin can use a solid color, an image or a youtube video

- **Enable Supplier Selection:** You can also privatize suppliers from here.
- **Enable Manufacture Selection:** You can also privatize manufactures from here.
- **Enable CMS Selection:** You can also privatize selected pages

- **Default Value:** This will be the default value for this field
- **Editable:** If enabled user will be able to edit the data later



- **Values Required:** Option to make this field mandatory
- **Field Status:** Enable to enable the field
- **Dependent Field:** Option to make filed dependable. More on this in next step

Dependent Fields

Dependable fields are those fields where input option is dependent on what user selects. See the image below for more clarification.

- When you are adding a field from backend enable dependent field option at the end.

- Next Select the field on which current field will be dependent.
- Then select dependent field value

Now your current field will only appear if the customer selects “1.7.x.x” option in the “Favorite Prestashop version” option.
