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## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Log in to **PrestaShop** administration panel, go to **Modules** → Click **Add new module**
2. Select **v1.0.0restrictshopaccess.zip** which you have downloaded and click **Upload this Module**
3. Scroll down and find **Restrict Shop Access by Country, IP, User-Agent** and click **Install**.
4. **Clear Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**



## USER GUIDE

### HOW TO CONFIGURE THE MODULE

At the back office, go to **Modules > Module Manager > Restrict Shop Access by Country, IP, User-Agent**. Here you will find the module configurations.

- **Enable Restrictions:** Option to enable / disable the restrictions.
- **Restriction Type:** Option to choose the restrictions for whole store or for a specific pages.
  - **Restriction Category:** Option to restrict the access to the selected categories.
  - **Restrict CMS Pages:** Option to restrict access to the selected CMS pages for blocked IP's or user agents.
  - **Restrict Product:** Option to restrict the blocked Ip's or user agents to access the selected products.
- **Message for Restricted Area:** Option to display a customized message to the blocked users by using WYSIWYG editor.
- **Restriction Redirect URL:** Option to redirect the restricted users to some URL or to the customer request page access.
- **Schedule Restriction:** Restriction can be scheduled for a specific date to start and end.



## BLOCK BY IP/COUNTRY

Admin can restrict users by their IP addresses or Countries as well.

- **IP's to Block:** Option to restrict multiple IP's separated by comma.

- **MaxMind Account ID:** Option to block users from the selected countries.
- **MaxMind License Key:** Option to block users from the selected countries.

**Note:** In case of Country Base Restriction, MaxMind account should be created.



## BLOCK BY USER AGENT

Admin can restrict the store by various user agents.

Option to add multiple user agents to restrict. You can selected a UA and then enter its specific version for restriction. For more then one versions you can easily add one more rule here.



## BLOCK BY EMAIL

Admin can restrict the store or specific pages by Email.
