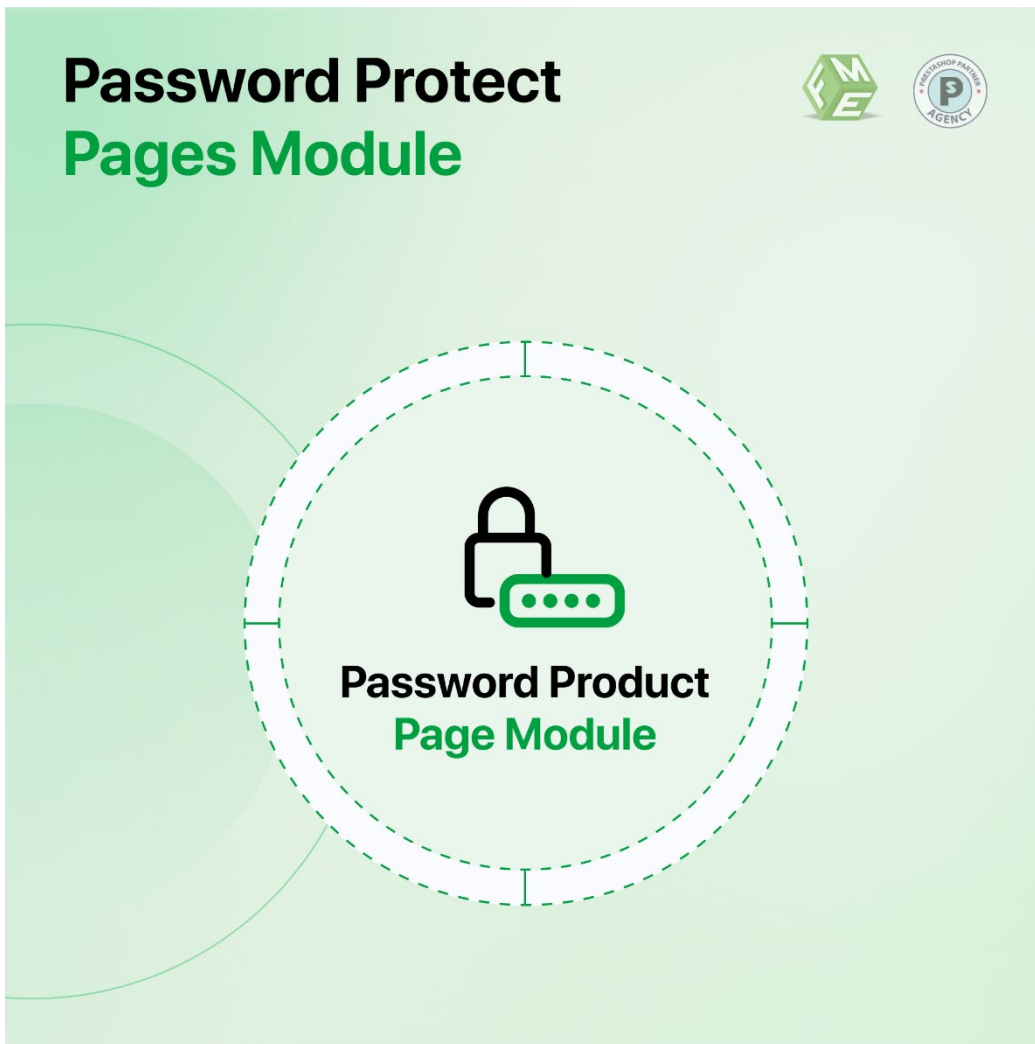

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Log in to PrestaShop administration panel, go to Modules → Click Add new module
2. Select v1.0.0passwordprotectpcp.zip which you have downloaded and click Upload this Module
3. Scroll down and find Password Protect Product, Categories & Pages and click Install.
4. Clear Cache in Advance Parameters → Performance

USE CASES

Exclusive Wholesale Access:

A business selling both retail and wholesale may want to offer exclusive access to certain product categories for wholesale buyers. By setting up password protection on these categories, the business can ensure that only verified wholesale clients can view and purchase from these pages. This prevents retail customers from accessing wholesale prices and maintains a controlled buying experience for different customer segments.

Members-Only Products:

Some eCommerce stores offer members-only products, such as limited-edition items or early-access sales. This module can be used to password-protect certain product categories so only registered members can access them. By distributing the password to members only, the store creates a sense of exclusivity, encouraging sign-ups and fostering customer loyalty.

Restricted Access for Pre-Launch Campaigns:

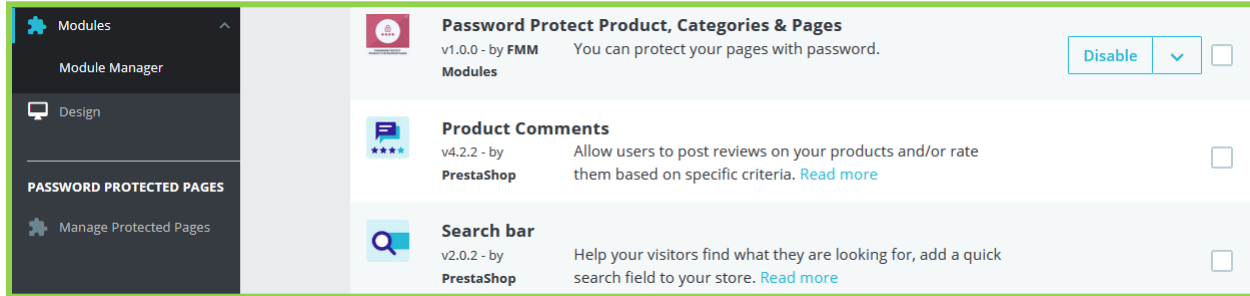
Businesses planning to launch a new product collection may use the password protection feature to create a “coming soon” area, allowing only selected customers or VIPs to preview products before the public launch. By sharing the password with a targeted audience, they can gauge interest, collect early feedback, and build anticipation without making the products publicly available yet.

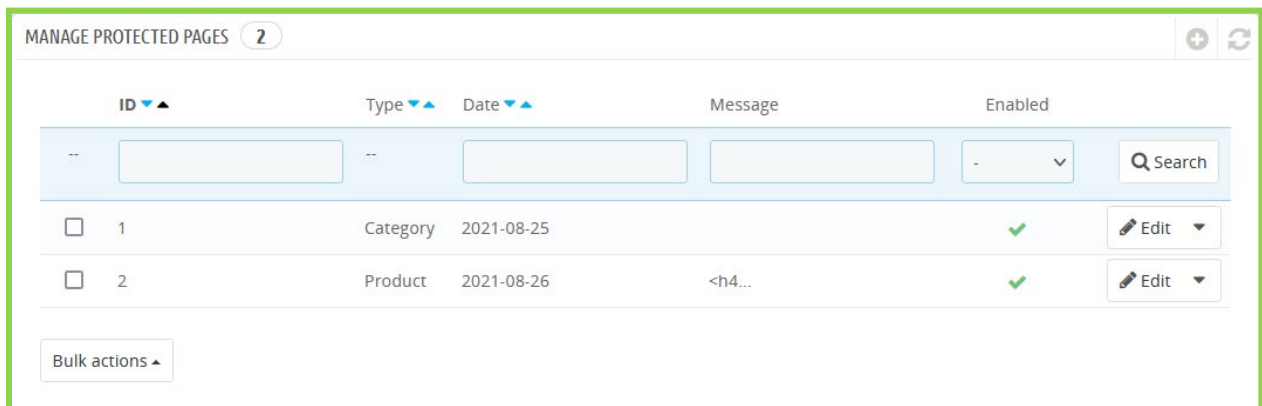
HOW TO CONFIGURE MODULE

At the back office, go to Modules > Module Manager > Password Protect Product, Categories & Pages. From here admin can enable or disable the module.



MANAGE PROTECTED PAGES

Admin can manage all the password protected pages rules from here. Click on + to add a new rule.



ADD PASSWORD PROTECTION ON PRODUCT, CATEGORIES & PAGES

Admin can Protect the desired product, categories or pages by creating passwords.

- **ACTIVE:** Option to enable / disable the password protection.
- **PAGE:** Option to choose the desired pages. Admin can choose the following pages:
 - **Product:** Will allow you to only select particular products that will be password protected
 - **Category:** All the products in selected categories will be restricted.
 - **CMS:** Selected CMS pages will be restricted
 - **Brands:** Option to restrict products from particular brands only
 - **Suppliers:** Option to restricted products from particular suppliers only
 - **Meta Pages:** Option to restricted meta pages

- **CUSTOMER GROUPS:** The pages selected above will only be restricted to the users belonging to the customer group selected by you here. You can leave it empty to disable this function.
- **MESSAGE:** Option to display custom message on the frontend using WYSIWYG editor.
