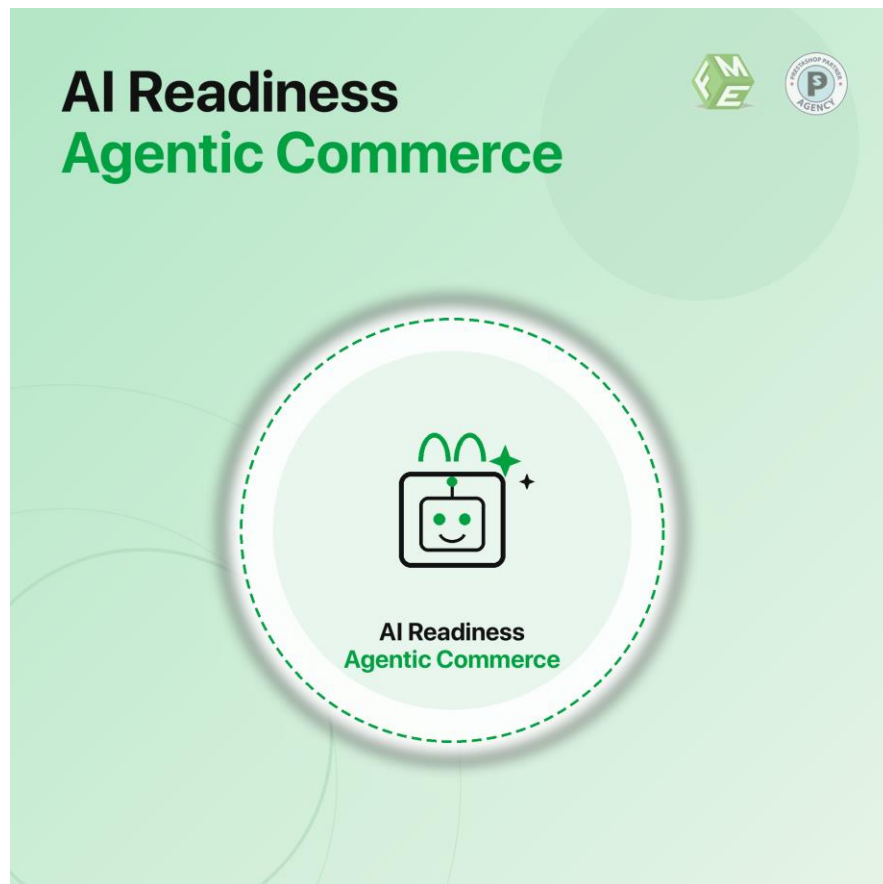

Equip your PrestaShop store to be discovered and transacted with by AI shopping agents — with AI-ready product feeds, ACP/UCP/MCP protocol support, agentic cart & checkout APIs, and a built-in readiness scanner to keep you compliant.

Installation Instructions

1. Go to Modules → Module Manager → Click Upload a Module → Browse for the Downloaded Module ZIP file and click Upload this module.
2. Click Proceed with Installation.
3. Make sure Cache is disabled in Advanced Parameters → Performance.
4. Go to Modules → Modules Manager → Agentic Commerce.

Product Feed

Admin can configure and generate product feeds that can be used for Agentic Commerce. From this page, the admin can choose the feed format, select the languages and currencies to include, generate the feed, and view the status of previously generated feeds.

Product Feed Configuration

The Product Feed section contains the following settings:

- **Enable Product Feed:** Use this option to enable or disable product feed generation.
- **Feed Format:** Select the format in which the product feed will be generated, either JSON or XML.
- **Feed Languages:** Select one or more languages for which the product feed should be generated.
- **Feed Currencies:** Select one or more currencies to include in the product feed.



Feed Status

The **Feed Status** table displays information about the generated product feeds. This information includes: language, currency, feed URL, mode, last run, status, items, and errors.

Protocol

Admin can configure the core Agentic Commerce settings, manage the API key, and view the public endpoints generated by the module.

Agentic Commerce Settings

1. **Enable Agentic Commerce:** Use this option to enable or disable the Agentic Commerce functionality.
2. **Allow AI Product Feed:** Use this option to allow or block access to the AI product feed.
3. **Allow Agent Cart Checkout Link:** Use this option to enable or disable the checkout link functionality.



API Key

The API Key section allows the admin to view, manage, or generate a new key used by the module.

Endpoint Preview

The Endpoint Preview section lists the public endpoints generated by the module. These links are active and ready to use. Admin can share or register these links in the agent platform or integration settings as required.

Agentic Commerce Settings

Agents can discover products and send customers to your store checkout. Payment is completed on your normal PrestaShop checkout.

API Key

Important: Do not change this key unless there is a security reason. If you change it, all AI agents and integrations using the old key will stop working until you update them with the new key.

This key is used for security. It allows only trusted AI agents to access your cart link APIs and helps block unknown or unauthorized agent access to your store.

Share this key only with trusted integrations. Keep it private and never publish it on your website or in public code.

Crawlers & llms.txt

Admin can configure the LLM and robots file from here.

AI Crawler Access

Using this section, the admin can manage which AI crawlers are allowed or blocked from accessing the store. Admin can also define custom crawler rules and apply them to the **robots.txt** file.

1. **Allowed AI Crawlers:** The admin can choose from a list of popular AI crawlers from various providers, which ones can access the store.
2. **Custom Allowed Crawlers:** The Custom Allowed Crawlers field lets you specify additional crawler user-agents that are not included in the predefined list.
3. **Custom Blocked Crawlers:** The Custom Blocked Crawlers field allows you to specify crawler user-agents that should be blocked.

llms.txt

The **llms.txt** page allows you to configure and generate the **llms.txt** file for your store. This page lets you define optional information that will be included in the generated file and preview its content before publishing.

- **Enable llms.txt:** Use this option to enable or disable the llms.txt file.
- **Support Email:** Enter the support email address to include in the generated llms.txt file.
- **Support URL:** Enter the URL of your support or contact page.



- **Sitemap URL:** Specify the sitemap URL that should be referenced in the generated llms.txt file.
- **Rate Limit Note:** Enter a message guiding automated requests.
- **Shipping Policy URL:** Enter the URL of your shipping policy.
- **Returns Policy URL:** Enter the URL of your returns policy.
- **Privacy Policy URL:** Enter the URL of your privacy policy.
- **Terms URL:** Enter the URL of your terms and conditions page.
- **File Path:** Displays the location where the generated llms.txt file is stored on the server.
- **Content:** The Content field displays the generated contents of the llms.txt file.

The robots.txt Editor page allows you to view and edit your store's **robots.txt** file directly from the module. You can review the current contents, make changes if required, generate the default file, and save your updates.

Readiness Check

The AI Readiness Scanner page allows you to evaluate your store's readiness for Agentic Commerce. It performs a series of automated checks and displays the overall readiness score, detailed results, and previous scan history.

Run Readiness Scan

Click Run readiness scan to perform a new readiness check.

The scanner evaluates the current configuration of your store and updates the results shown on the page.
