INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Compatible - PrestaShop 1.6.x - 1.7.x

1. Log in to **PrestaShop** administration panel, go to **Modules** → Click **Add new module**
2. Select **v1.0.0privatecmspages.zip** which you have downloaded and click **Upload this Module**
3. Scroll down and find **Private CMS Pages** and click **Install**
4. **Clear Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**
