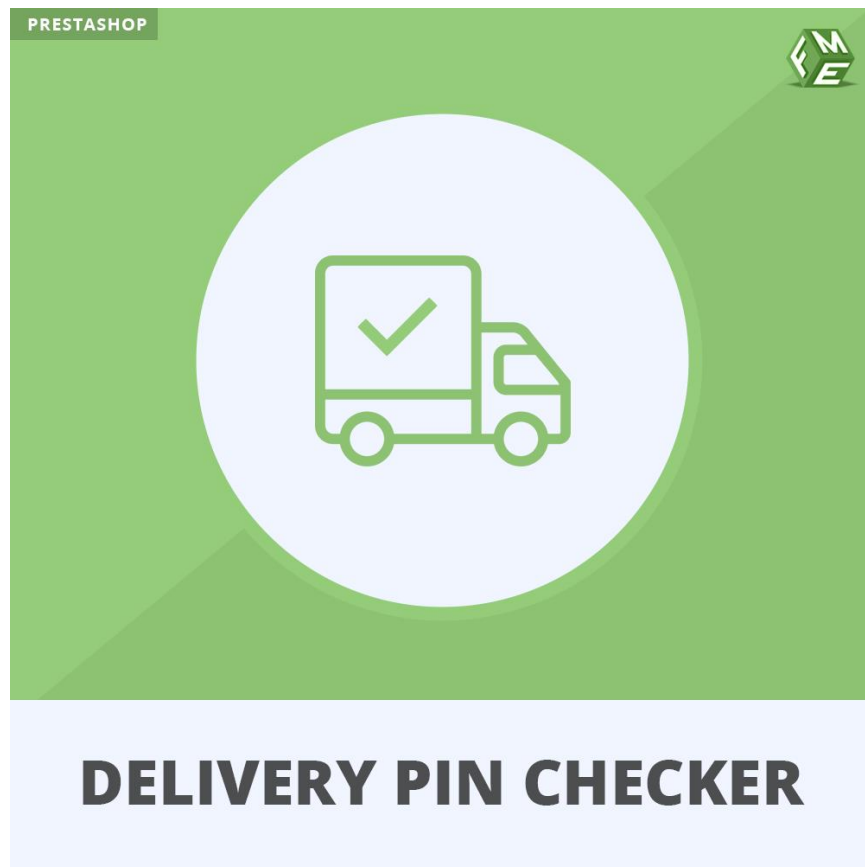

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Log in to **PrestaShop** administration panel, go to **Modules** → Click **Add new module**
2. Select **v1.0.0deliverypincheck.zip** which you have downloaded and click **Upload this Module**
3. Scroll down and find "**Delivery Pin Checker**" and click **Install**
4. **Clear Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**

HOW TO CONFIGURE MODULE

At the back office, go to **Modules > Module Manager > Delivery Checker**. From here admin can uninstall, disable or reset the module.

- **Check Button Text Color:** Option to set the "Check" text for the button.
- **Font Color:** Option to set the font color for heading.

- **Weekend Delivery Availability:** Option to enable weekend delivery availability.
- **Select Not deliverable products:** Option to add multiple products which will not deliver on the ZIP codes listed above.
