# Getting Started!

## Overview

---

Create dynamic pricing rules with unmatched flexibility. Apply price increases, reductions, or fixed overrides based on products, categories, suppliers, customer groups, and more. Includes scheduling, quantity ranges, and discount display options.



## Installation Instructions

---

1. Go to Modules → Modules Manager → Click Upload a Module → Browse for Downloaded Module ZIP file and click Upload this module.
2. Click Proceed with Installation.
3. Make sure Cache is disabled in Advance Parameters → Performance.
4. Go to Modules → Modules Manager → Advance Pricing Rules to enable the module



# User Guide

## Rules Configuration:

After the installation of module, you will see a new tab in Sell > Catalog > Advance Pricing Rule. Here you will be able to see the rules that you have already created, click on plus button to add a new rule.

## Adding a new rule:

**PRICE RULE**    CONDITIONS

\* Rule Name:

Active:  Disabled

Priority:   
Rules with lower numbers have higher priority. 0 is applied before 1, 1 before 2, and so on.

\* Price Change Mode:

\* Price Change Type:

Fix Value:   
The fix amount you want to add in the mode

\* Apply On Price:   
Select the price you want the percentage of the increment/reduction to be calculated on the base of, the calculated percentage will be implemented on the original price

Skip Discounted Products:  No  
Skip products that already have a discount.

Display as Discount:  No  
Used for reductions, select whether to display the reduction as a discount

Enable Product Exclusion:  No

- Rule Name: Enter a custom name to identify the pricing rule.
- Active: Toggle to enable or disable the rule.
- Priority: Set the rule’s priority to determine which rule applies first when multiple rules overlap.



## FME Modules

- Price Change Mode: Choose how the price will be adjusted — increase, reduce, or set a fixed value.
- Price Change Type: Define whether the change is a fixed amount, a percentage, or a combination of both.
- Apply On Base Price: Select the base price (retail, wholesale, or supplier) used for price calculation, with or without tax.
- Skip Discounted Products: Enable this to prevent the rule from applying to already discounted products.
- Display as Discount: Choose whether to show the price change as a visible discount on the frontend.
- Enable Product Exclusion: Turn on this option to exclude specific products from the pricing rule.

- Enable User Group Selection: Activate to apply the rule only to selected customer groups.
- Enable Product Selection: Enable this option to target specific products for the pricing rule.
- Enable Category Selection: Turn on to apply the rule to selected product categories.
- Enable Supplier Selection: Activate to apply the rule to products from chosen suppliers.
- Enable Manufacturer Selection: Enable to target products from specific manufacturers.
- Enable Quantity Selection: Set a quantity range (min/max) that triggers the rule.
- Enable Rule Schedule: Define a start and end date to schedule when the rule is active.
