INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Log in to [PrestaShop](#) administration panel, go to [Modules](#) → Click [Add new module](#)
2. Select [fmmrestrictorderquantity.zip](#) which you have downloaded and click [Upload this Module](#)
3. Scroll down and find [Limit Cart Quantity](#) and click [Install](#).
4. [Clear Cache](#) in [Advance Parameters](#) → [Performance](#)

USE CASES

Use Case 1: Enforcing Bulk Purchase Rules

A wholesale store wants to set a minimum order quantity of 10 units for certain products to ensure bulk purchases. Using the Order Limit Module, the store owner can enforce this rule, preventing smaller, non-bulk orders and maintaining efficient inventory management.

Use Case 2: Controlling High-Demand Product Sales

A store selling high-demand or limited-stock items, like event tickets or exclusive collectibles, wants to restrict customers to a maximum of 2 units per order to ensure fair distribution. The module allows the store owner to set these limits, preventing stock depletion by a few customers.

Use Case 3: Managing Promotional Product Orders

A store running a promotion on discounted items wants to limit the quantity each customer can purchase to avoid reselling or stockpiling. With the Order Limit Module, the store can set order caps for promotional products, ensuring more customers can benefit from the deal.
