INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

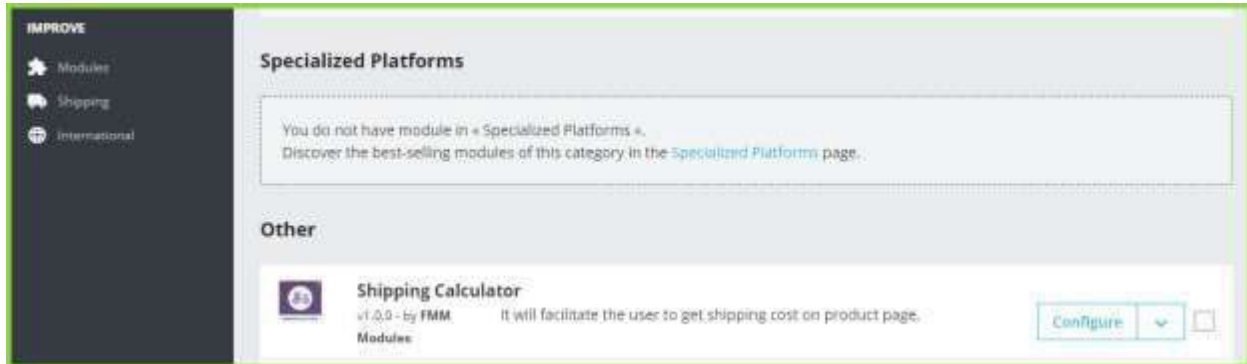
1. Log into **PrestaShop** administration panel, go to **Modules** → Click Add new module
2. Select **shippingcalculator.zip** which you downloaded and click upload this Module
3. Scroll down and find **Shipping Calculator** and click **Install**. You are done
4. **Clear Cache** in **Advance Parameters** → **Performance**

HOW TO CONFIGURE THE MODULE

At the back office, go to **Shipping Calculator**. You can go there from **IMPROVE > Modules > Modules & Services > Shipping Calculator**.



Click on **Configure** to Continue.

Here you will find the following configurations:

SETTINGS

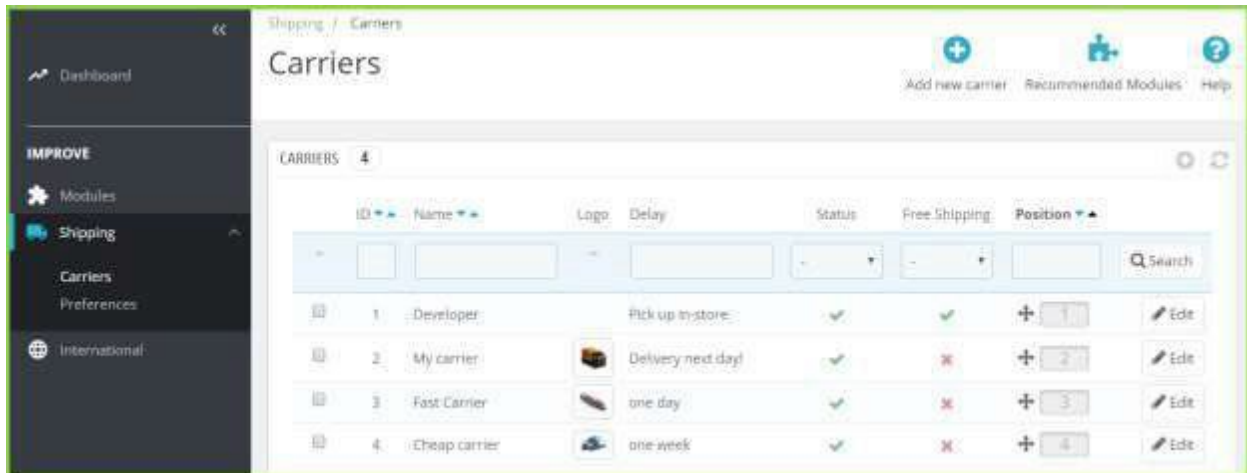
- **Allow city field:** Enable/Disable city field to show in shipping estimate form
- **Allow Zipcode field:** Enable/Disable Zipcode field to show in shipping estimate form





HOW TO ADD CARRIERS

At the back office, go to **Carriers**. You can go there from **IMPROVE > Shipping > Carriers**. Here you will find a grid with all the carriers. Click on **+** to add new carrier.



Here you will find the following settings.

General Settings

- **Carrier name:** Allowed characters: letters, spaces and "().-". The carrier's name will be displayed during checkout. For in-store pickup, enter 0 to replace the carrier name with your shop name
- **Transit time:** The delivery time will be displayed during checkout
- **Speed grade:** Enter 0 for the longest shipping delay, or 9 for the shortest shipping delay
- **Logo: Format:** JPG, GIF, PNG. Filesize: 8.00 MB max. Current size: undefined
- **Tracking URL:** For example, 'http://example.com/track.php?num=@' with '@' where the tracking number should appear

Size, weight, group access

- **Maximum package width (cm):** Maximum width managed by this carrier. Set the value to "0", or leave this field blank to ignore. The value must be an integer
- **Maximum package height (cm):** Maximum height managed by this carrier. Set the value to "0", or leave this field blank to ignore. The value must be an integer
- **Maximum package depth (cm):** Maximum depth managed by this carrier. Set the value to "0", or leave this field blank to ignore. The value must be an integer
- **Maximum package weight (kg):** Maximum weight managed by this carrier. Set the value to "0", or leave this field blank to ignore
- **Group access:** Mark the groups that are allowed access to this carrier

At the back office, go to **Locations**. You can go there from **IMPROVE > International > Locations**. Here you tab with **Countries**, **Zones** and **States**. Each tab displayed a grid with countries, zones, and states respectively. Click on **+** on the country section to continue.

Here you will find the following settings.

STATES

- **Name:** Provide the state name to be displayed in addresses and on invoices
- **ISO code:** 1 to 4 letter ISO code. You can prefix it with the country ISO code if needed
- **Country:** Country where the state is located. Only the countries with the option "contains states" enabled are displayed
- **Zone:** Geographical region where this state is located. Used for shipping
